This approach ensures that students fully appreciate the different points of view on these issues. At the same time, the students gain additional skills needed to conduct research on innovative approach for health management and epidemiology in the context of sustainable development in GMS and ASEAN region and beyond.

- Statement of purpose, documenting the applicant's reasons for pursuing a Master's degree in this field of study and his/her related background and experience
- A certified copy of undergraduate transcripts, confirming that all Bachelor's degree requirements have been met, and of a certified copy of a Bachelor's degree
- English proficiency score report (TOEFL, IELTS, MFU-TEGS, CU-TEPS, etc.)
- Doctor's medical report (certification)
- Passport (for non-Thai citizens)
- Recent 1 –inch Photograph
